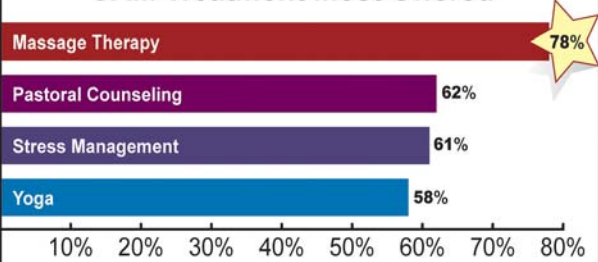


Hospitals Frequently Offer Massage

A survey conducted by the American Hospital Association found the number of hospitals that offer complementary and alternative medicine (CAM) therapies increased from 8 percent in 1998 to 16.7 percent in 2002. Of the CAM therapies offered in both hospital inpatient and offsite wellness centers, massage was the most common:
